
What is a K-Shaped Recovery?



COVID-19 Caused Initial Steep Decline, Eventual Leveling









UNEMPLOYMENT RATE




UNEMPLOYED BY EDUCATION LEVEL


Leisure, Hospitality Sectors See Highest Job Loss During Pandemic





Despite Early Declines, Sales Rebounded




